Open Forum: Marcie Klomp came before the board to remind everyone that she at the meetings representing the paper. She noted that all meetings are taped and anything said can be read in the paper or listened to on tape at a later date. **Casey Sebastian** came before the board thanking everyone that he had worked with in the past and wished everyone well. When asked, he is going to work for Iowa Rural Water for Eastern Iowa.

Agenda, Previous Month Minutes and Financials: Kraft made a motion to approve the Agenda, Previous Month Minutes and Financial reports. Smith 2nd. Kraft, DeVries, Norton and Smith voted aye. McNamara was absent.

Financial Report: Accounts Past Due was printed and given to council for their own review.

Department Heads:

Fire Department: Fire Chief Nathan Schwickerath was present. Schwickerath reported that 2 AirPack Vendors came in and gave presentations for costs. Fire Dept assisted with power outage on Thursday, May 28. The fireman have scheduled a Golf Tournament in Elma on June 22nd as a fundraiser. Nate showed the board and visitors the flag that came from the Roger Foote family and asked for it to be displayed. Nate gave an update on the Tienter Building, the cost for the asbestos removal may make it too expensive to make it feasible for him and Steve Jenkins as is.

Park/Pool: Jill Tibbals was present. The Pool and Park is waiting for final decision for pool opening. The Governor gave the OK for parks to re-open as of June 1st. Pool & Park agreed with the council to leave the water turned off at Brown Park currently and to open the park. Ball is not going to open for the kids in Lime Springs, as coaches didn't think they would get enough kids' participation this year. Jill asked for painters for the pool for the coming weekend. The paint will need 7 to 10 days for drying time and curing before water can be put in.

Sherriff Mike Miner reported that he had received a grant for a flashing speed limit sign to be placed by Leverson's shop on W Merrill Street. Kraft made a motion for \$ 700.00 towards the flashing speed limit sign. Smith 2nd the motion. The motion passed with all voted Aye.

Public Works Director Report: Casey Sebastian was present. Sebastian reported that the Control Panel at the Sewer plant will be installed this week. Currently the 2 aerators are not working due to lightning strike. The City will be checking with insurance to see what is covered for the aerators. Sebastian reported Corey Gates put brakes in the city truck. The stop sign has not been put in yet, waiting to see what proper procedure is. Dust control pricing sheets from Farmer's Feed from Riceville was presented. Currently the city has 4700 feet of streets that are gravel. Amy Norton agreed with Sebastian that tours should be given of the sewer plant, it really helped her to see what was being talked about. Ed Hampe is going to test water during the week and Norton & DeVries is going to test on weekends

Sebastian reported 2 building permits granted. One to Gary Klomp for a garage and one to Mark Bowen for cement work. Jane will contact Dana Ruggeberg and Brian Jessen for clarification on their building permits.

Kraft made a motion to table everything else on the agenda and to continue the meeting next week at same time, due to current weather conditions. Norton 2nd. All voted aye.
